### Directions by Road

#### From the North M6, M62, A49

Leave the M6 at Junction 21a and join M62 Liverpool. Follow the M62 to the next junction - Junction 9 - and join the A49, signposted 'Warrington'. Follow the A49 through two roundabouts. With McDonalds on your right, turn right at the traffic lights. Follow this road over a hump-backed bridge and through two sets of traffic lights. When you have gone under a further railway bridge, the hospital will be clearly visible on your left hand side.

#### From the West A57, A562 and A5080

The A5080 joins the A562 which then joins the A57 at a roundabout at the beginning of a dual carriageway. Follow this dual carriageway through one set of traffic lights until you come to a large roundabout with traffic lights. Take the first exit off the roundabout onto Lovely Lane. Continue on this road until you pass a church (St Barnabas) on your right. The hospital is on your right-hand side.

#### From the South M6

Leave the M6 at Junction 21a and join the M62 Liverpool. Follow the M62 to the next junction - Junction 9 - and join the A49, signposted 'Warrington'. Follow the A49 through two roundabouts. With McDonalds on your right, turn right at the traffic lights. Follow this road over a hump-backed bridge and through two sets of traffic lights. When you have gone under a further railway bridge, the Hospital will be clearly visible on your left-hand side.

#### From the South M56, A56, A49 and A559

Leave the M56 and Junction 10 and follow the A49, signposted 'Warrington'. The A559 joins the A49 at the roundabout at Junction 10 of the M56. The A56 becomes the A5060 and joins the A49 at a

small roundabout with the Village Hotel on your left.

Keep in the left-hand lane approaching the traffic lights at the Bridge Foot roundabout.

Following the signs for Liverpool A57, turn left over the bridge, pass MFI on left and British Rail Bank Quay Station also on left. At this point the road turns sharply to the right.

Take the third exit off the roundabout onto Lovely Lane. Continue on this road until you pass a church (St Barnabas) on your right. The hospital is on your right-hand side.

#### **From the East, M62, A57**

Leave the M62 at Junction 9 and join the A49 signposted 'Warrington'.

Follow the A49 through two roundabouts.

With McDonalds on your right, turn right at the traffic lights.

Follow this road over a hump-back bridge and through two sets of traffic lights.

When you have gone under a further clearly visible on your left-hand side.

#### **From A57**

Follow the A57 through the town passing a large graveyard on your left. At the next set of traffic lights the road bears right passing Sainsburys on the left. Go straight through the roundabout, under a railway bridge. Go through 1 set of traffic lights. The road bears to the right.

Turn left at the next traffic lights. (McDonalds on left hand corner through the traffic lights).

Follow the road over a hump-back bridge and through the 2 sets of traffic lights. Pass under a further railway bridge and the hospital will be clearly visible on the left-hand side.

#### **Directions to Warrington Hospital by Rail**

##### **From Central Station (Liverpool - Manchester local services)**

On leaving the station, cross the road on the pelican crossing and turn right past a number of bus shelters and a motorbike showroom. Turn left at the petrol station and follow the road under a railway bridge and then over a hump-back bridge. Once over the bridge take the first right-turn into Guardian Street which brings you to the rear of the hospital. The walk brings you to the rear of the hospital. The walk takes approximately 15 minutes.

##### **From Bank Quay Station (London, Birmingham, Crewe, Scotland, etc.)**

Turn left on leaving the station. The Patterns Arms Hotel is opposite. Go straight on at the traffic lights with the park on your right (Crosfield Street). Turn left at the T junction, over the hump-back bridge and take the first right-turn (Guardian Street), which brings you to the rear of the hospital. The walk takes approximately 20 minutes.
